Pauline E. Mirizio, 79, of Syracuse, passed away December 7, 2022 at Crouse Hospital. She was born in Syracuse, daughter of the late Thomas and Mary Mirizio. Pauline received her master's in education and was a teacher at St. Anthony's School, retiring after many dedicated years. She was a devout Catholic and dedicated her life to her family. In lieu of flowers, donations may be made to Our Lady of Pompei/St. Peter Church Building Fund.

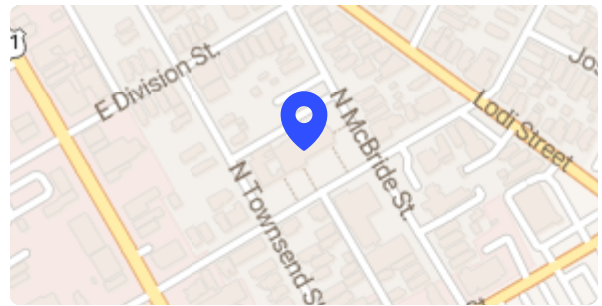

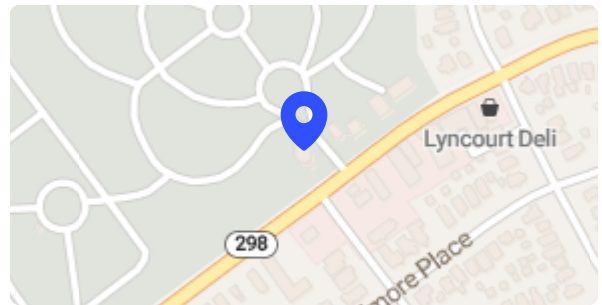
