Lucy D. Pirro, 99, of Syracuse, passed away peacefully at home on January 5, 2023. She was born in Syracuse, daughter of the late Pellegrino and Rafaella Pirro. Lucy worked at Camillus Cutlery for over 60 dedicated years. She was a longtime member of St. Brigid & St. Joseph Church, where she served as Eucharistic Minister. She was also a member of the Altar-Rosary Society, Molinese Italian Society, and Senior Citizens Club. Lucy volunteered with St. Brigid & St. Joseph Church food pantry, helped with their funeral luncheons, cleaned the church altar, and washed and pressed all the altar linens. Her hobbies included baking Italian cookies, making cookie trays for family celebrations, knitting, crocheting and traveling the world, visiting new places. Most of all, Lucy loved spending time with family and friends. Aunt Lucy was intelligent, fearless, feisty and had an adventurous spirit. 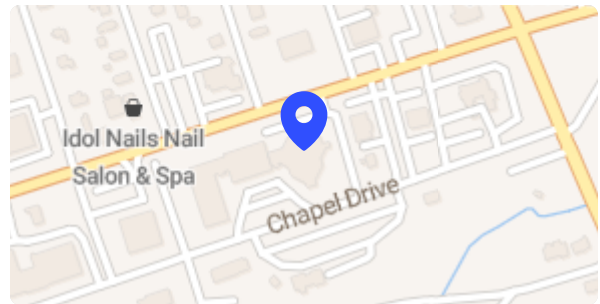

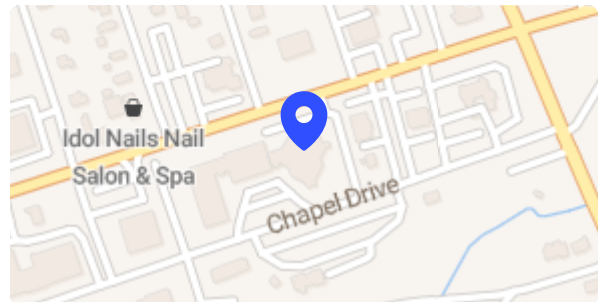

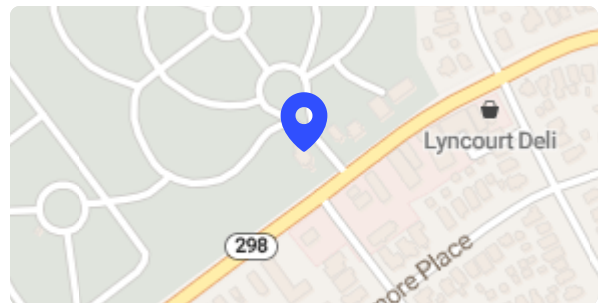
