# Rosemary DeJoseph

JUN 1, 1941 - JAN 8, 2023

**R**osemary DeJoseph, 81, passed away peacefully on January 8, 2023, in Florida. She was born and raised in Syracuse by the late Bernard “Duke” and Amalia (Delmonico) DeJoseph. Rosemary attended The Convent School and later received a BS degree from LeMoyne College. She earned a master’s degree in social work (MSW) from Syracuse University and was employed for many years in the healthcare field, eventually retiring from Hospice of CNY. She relocated to Florida in 2017.

In addition to her parents, she is predeceased by her first husband, Peter Giacobbi; her second husband, Michael Bucci; her son, Mark Giacobbi; and her brother, Bernie DeJoseph.

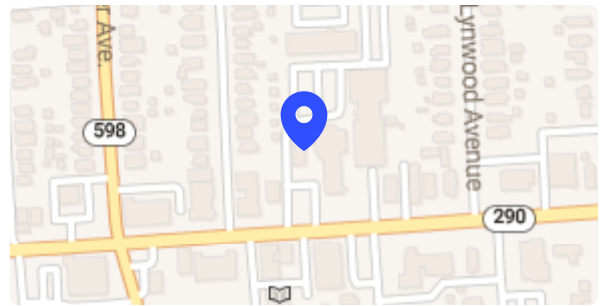

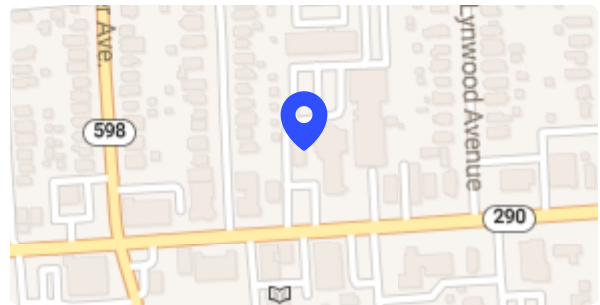

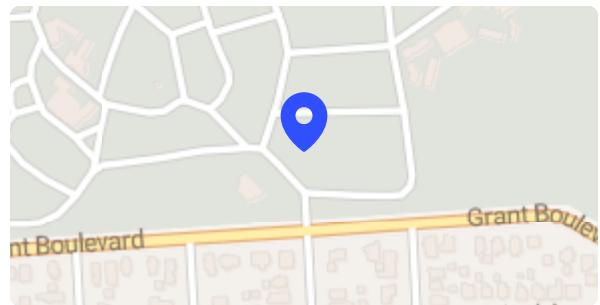
