Yolanda (Canestraro) Halpin passed away peacefully on March 3, 2023, two days before her 95th birthday. She had been a resident at the Jewish Home of CNY. Yolanda was born in Syracuse, daughter of the late Angeline and John Canestraro. She was a long-time employee of Niagara Mohawk and started as a dance instructor with the Arthur Murray Dance Studio. She would give in prompt-to dance lessons who were so inclined.

Yolanda was a family icon. A hilarious matriarch who loved pasta and champagne. Wherever she was, a celebration broke out. Family was everything to Yolanda except when she was pulling the lever at her favorite casino. She loved to travel and would hop a plane in a moment's notice. Her favorite place on earth was Las Vegas where she once dined in the company of Frank Sinatra. Her sisters remember her as a class clown and free spirit. Above all, she was loving and considerate as any sister could wish for. To family and friends, she was a mentor who could both challenge and affirm. 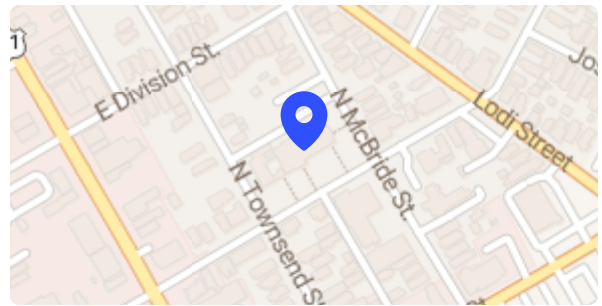

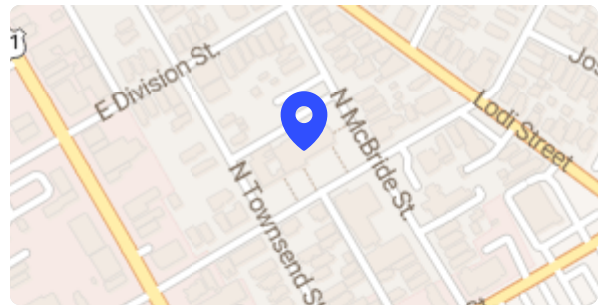

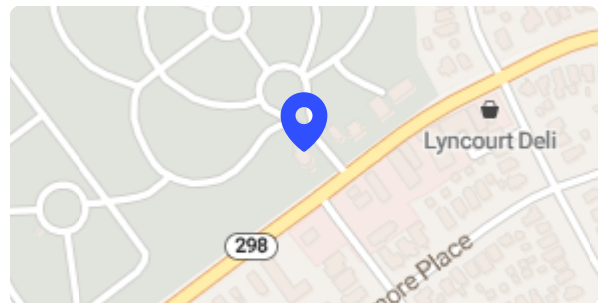
