Peter Anthony Cipriano, Sr., 79, of Minoa, passed away peacefully on Thursday, March 23, 2023, at HCA Florida Blake Hospital, Bradenton, surrounded by his loving family. Born in Syracuse to the late Elia and Filomena (Gugliano) Cipriano, Peter graduated from North High School and went on to serve as a Senior Master Sergeant from the 174th Air National Guard. After, he was the Assistant Commissioner of Security and Operation for the Onondaga County Correctional Facility. Peter was a Pop Warner Football Coach for Lyncourt Pop Warner and the Athletic Director for MKAA, also coaching basketball and baseball for them. Peter was a proud member of the Minoa Volunteer Fire Department/Ambulance EMT. Most of all, Peter loved to be with his family, especially his beloved children and grandchildren.

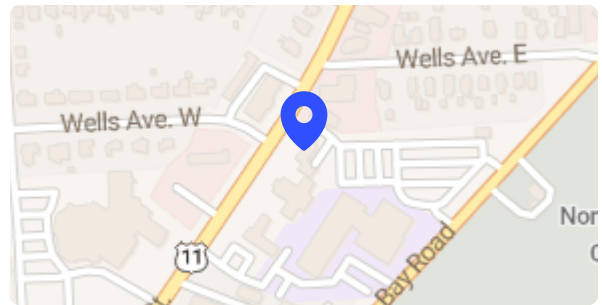
