After graduating from North High School, Toni became a secretary and worked at General Electric company for nine years. She then married Daniel Savino and together they had three beautiful daughters, Cindy, Cheryl, and Lori.

Toni was a stay-at-home mom for 14 years. Following that she worked as a part-time teaching assistant at Genesee Hills, and then went on to work as an executive secretary to the VP of RE Dietz company. Toni loved spending time in the kitchen creating delicious meals for her family and friends. She also loved it when everyone gathered around the kitchen table for Sunday dinners.

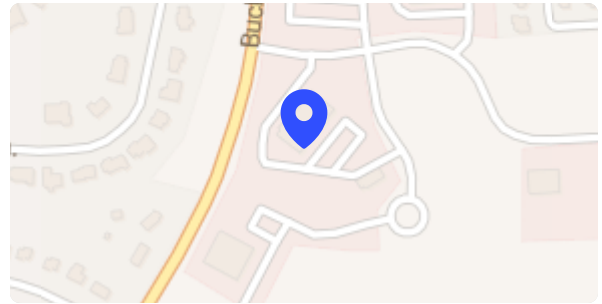

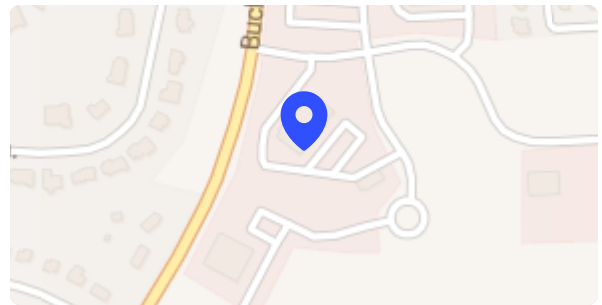

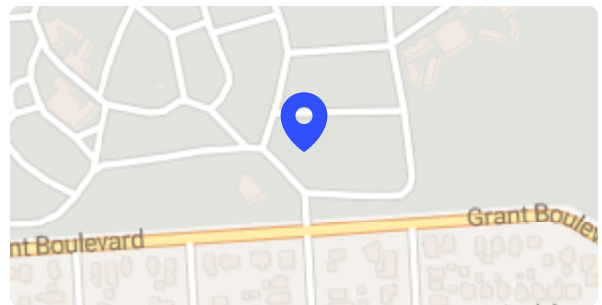
