Camille graduated from Syracuse University with a Bachelors Degree in Education and a Masters Degree as a Reading Specialist. She worked at Syracuse University Press as a proof reader and then was a teacher at Allen Road Elementary, retiring from the North Syracuse School District in 1993. Camille received the Business Woman of the Year award from ABWA in 1978 and was also honored as a Teacher of the Year for the North Syracuse School District. She was involved with Literacy Volunteers of Syracuse and was an avid reader.

She was predeceased by her husband, Joseph C. Accarino in 1990.
