## Patricia "Patti" (Bushnell) Sgroi

Patricia "Patti" (Bushnell) Sgroi, 80, of Baldwinsville, passed away suddenly on Monday, March 4, 2024 with her loving family by her side. 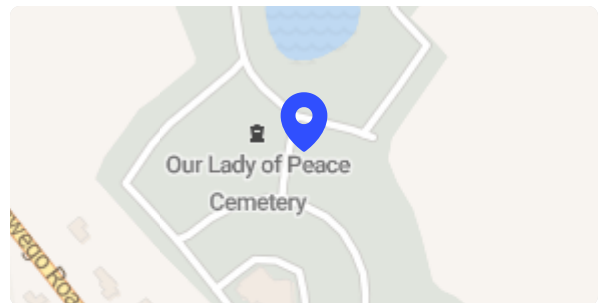
