**H**enry J. Henson III, 94, of North Syracuse, passed away peacefully on April 7, 2024 surrounded by his family. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather.

Henry married the love of his life, Jeanne Bachman on August 2, 1952, and built a life that honored faith and family above all else. They celebrated a marriage of 65 years of love and commitment. Veteran of the US Navy, Henry graduated from Syracuse University, retired from General Electric as a cost analyst, served as Justice of the Peace of North Syracuse from 1975-1985, and maintained memberships to the Liverpool Elks Club, State Magistrate Association and the Lorton Lake Association.

He and Jeanne's world revolved around their family and their treasured time at their camp on Lorton Lake in Altmar, NY. His favorite pastimes were gardening and fishing with his children and grandchildren. Henry will be deeply missed by all those who loved him.

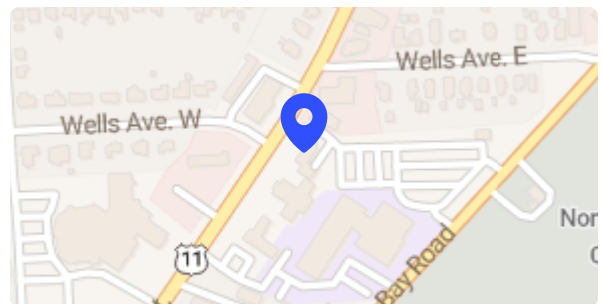

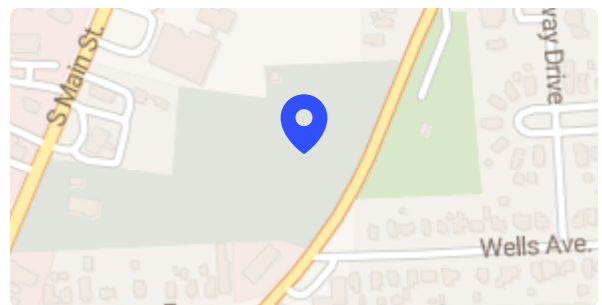

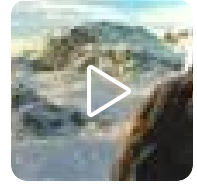
