Peter R. “Pete” Daino (91), a lifetime resident of Syracuse, NY, peacefully passed away on April 25, 2024, surrounded by his family after courageously battling dementia.

Peter was a graduate of North High School and served his country in the United States Airforce as a Staff Sergeant during the Korean Conflict. He retired from the General Electric Co. as an Engineering Manager in 1987 after 37 years of service. He then became a founder and officer of CID Technologies Inc., retiring again in 1990. Pete was member in good standing with the Syracuse GE Elfun Society as well as a lifelong member of St. Daniel’s Church.

He was a lifelong aviation enthusiast, held an Instrument Rated Private Pilot’s License, was an avid builder, and pilot of radio-controlled scale model aircraft. He also enjoyed mentoring many area flyers. He was always ready to help his family and friends that his family affectionately created the moniker, C.O.D. — Call On Dad.

Pete was predeceased by his wife of 46 years, Diane A. (Drumm) in 1999. He leaves his wife of 20 years, Rose (Zappola) Dreis, daughters, Debbie J. Stack, Sherry A. (Gregory) Bogardo, Linda S. (Mark) Condolora, son Robert J. (Pamela), twelve grandchildren and nine great grandchildren. Also surviving are his sister Susan M.
