Francis A. Notcher, 80, of Camillus, passed away June 29, 2024 in Colorado. He was born in Syracuse, son of the late Peter and Marie (Anthony) Notcher. Francis graduated from Solvay High School and received his bachelor's degree from Le Moyne College. He was a proud U.S. Air Force veteran. Francis worked as an account associate for Xerox Corporation, retiring after many dedicated years. He enjoyed fly fishing and could never say no to a beer. He had an infectious personality and became friends with everyone he met. Francis was a great man and loving husband and will be deeply missed.

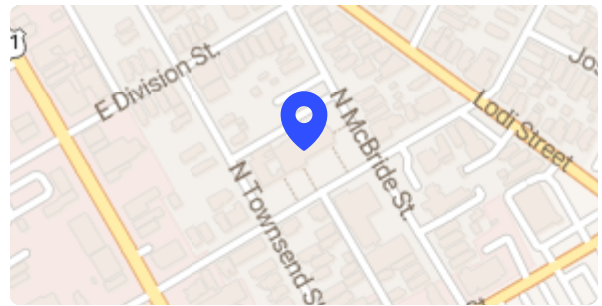

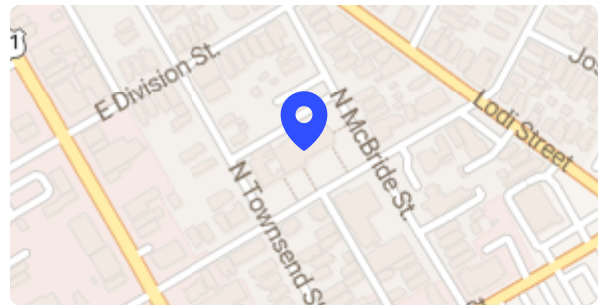

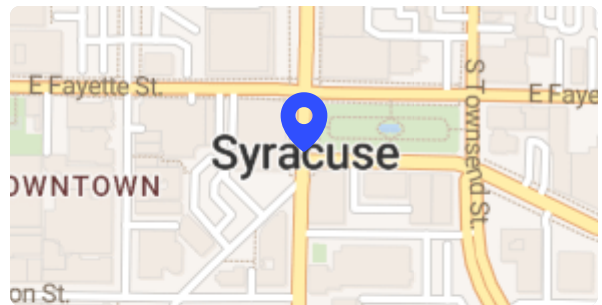
