## **Leonard Cordone**

MAY 31, 1918 - JAN 14, 2013

**L**eonard Cordone, 94, of East Syracuse, passed away Monday at St. Joseph's Hospital. He was born in Syracuse, the son of the late Saverio and Josephine (Carozza) Cordone. Leonard served with the US Navy during WWII as a Machinist's Mate on the USS Poinsett in the South Pacific. He was a Tool and Die Maker and Product Development Engineering Technician at Porter Cable/Rockwell Power Tool Division for over 30 years. He is named on several patents in the power tool industry. Leonard subsequently worked as a mechanical specialist and mechanical fabrication trouble-shooting specialist at Lamson Corporation and Microwave Filter Corporation. He was also a Mechanical Fabrication Special Consultant to Communications and Energy Corporation from its inception in 1992 until 2010. Leonard was highly skilled at metalwork and woodworking and repaired innumerable personal items for friends and family members throughout his life.

He was predeceased by his wife, Louise Cordone in 1990; his son, Leonard Gerald Cordone and siblings, Concetta Salerno, Anthony Cordone, Dominick Cordone and Rosemary Brennan. Leonard is survived by his sons, Lawrence Vincent Cordone of East Syracuse and Leslie (Michele) Cordone of Jamesville; grandchildren, Alaina and Guthrie Cordone; brother, Joseph Cordone of East Syracuse and daughter-in-law, Joyce Cordone of Rochester.
