Joseph M. Pastella, 72, of Liverpool, NY peacefully departed this world on Wednesday, January 29, 2025. Joe fought a courageous 5-year battle with cancer. His absence will be deeply felt by all who knew him.

Joe was born on November 9, 1952, in Syracuse, NY. An epic storyteller, talented musician, and devoted father, Joe saw the best in everyone and was quick to lend a helping hand.
