In lieu of flowers, contributions in Helen's memory may be made to the ASPCA.

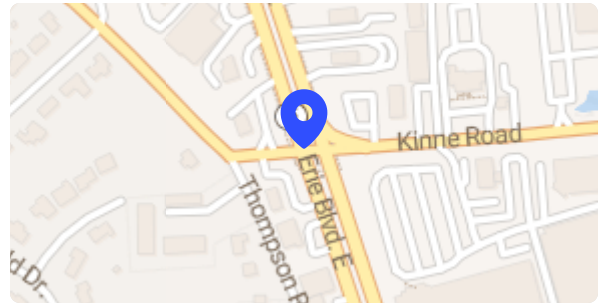
