In keeping with Donald's wishes, there will be no funeral services. He will be laid to rest in White Chapel Memory Gardens, Syracuse.



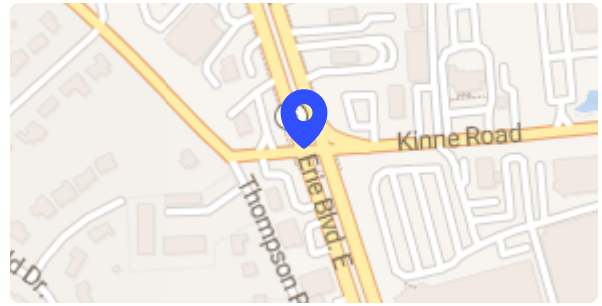
