Francesco "Frank" Colosi, 98, of East Syracuse, passed away peacefully surrounded by his loving family on July 24, 2025 at St. Joseph's Hospital. He was born in Gualtieri Sicaminò Messina, Sicily, son of the late Paul and Antonia (Calapa) Colosi, and served in the Italian Army. 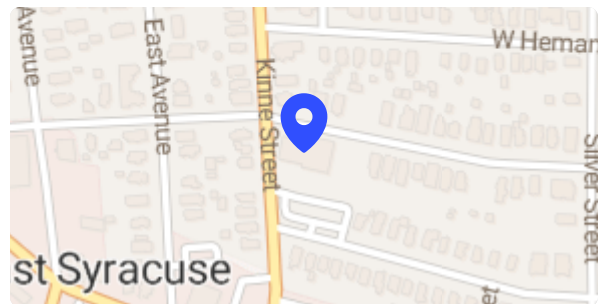
