Louis Joseph Poletto, 86 years young of Liverpool, NY joined the Lord his God on February 14, 2013 with his children and Rev. Robert Hyde by his side. Born to Jerome and Carmella (Ferigino) Poletto on August 17, 1926, he grew up in Carbondale, Pennsylvania. Following his honorable discharge from the United States Navy, he moved to Syracuse, NY where he met his bride, Rose. Louis was a dedicated and extremely loving husband, father and grandfather. A steadfast Yankee fan for most of his life, he loved the game and his team. He was a member of St. Daniel's parish for 20 years.
