FEB 14, 1914 - MAR 11, 2013

Carmella "Millie" (Ilacqua) Aloï, 99, of Syracuse, passed away peacefully on Monday at Loretto Fahey. She was born in Syracuse, the daughter of the late Peter and Fortunata (LaMacchia) Ilacqua. Millie was a seamstress with Jacquin Dry Cleaners for over 35 years. She was a communicant of Our Lady of Pompei Church and a member of its St. Therese Society. Millie was also a member of the Progresso Lodge and Daughters of Columbus. She enjoyed crocheting and made baby blankets for family and her friends new born babies. Millie loved cooking and lived to feed her family and provided "care packages" to everyone.

She was predeceased by her husband, Frank Aloï in 1993; brothers, Frank, Bart, Tony and Joseph Ilacqua and sisters, Jennie DeSalvo and Catherine Praino. 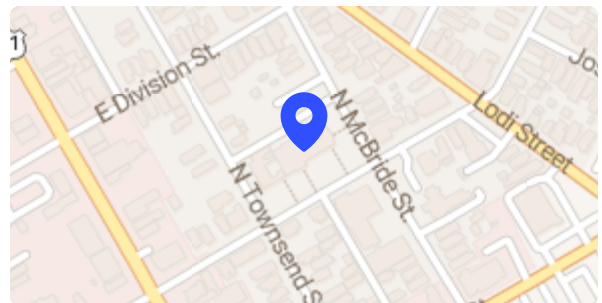

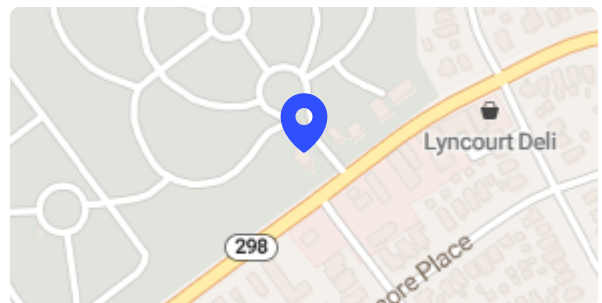

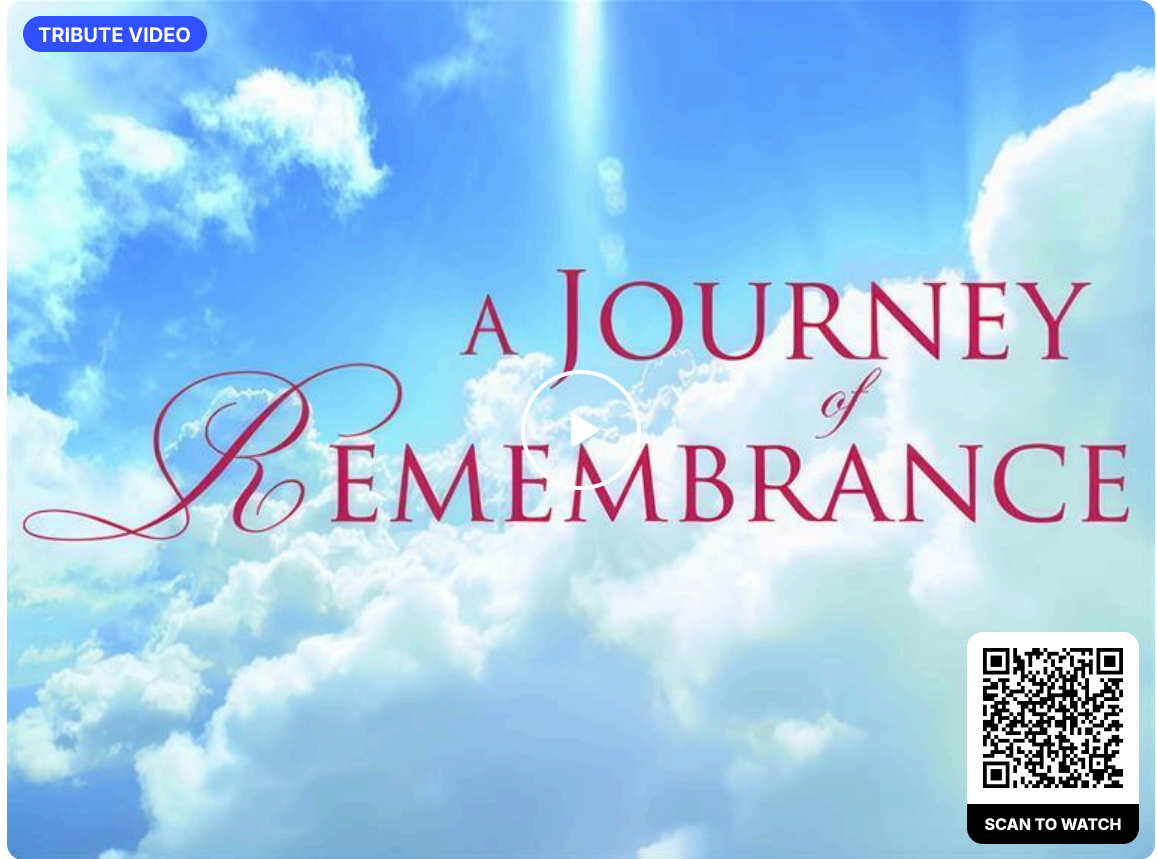
