Patrick W. "Lozzy" Nesci, 74, passed away peacefully at home, surrounded by his loving family on June 3, 2022. Lozzy spent his life focusing on his two loves: his family, and C. Nesci Produce, a fifty-year-old business he started out of his car and grew into one of the largest produce businesses in the area. He was a devoted and loyal father, husband, brother, grandfather, father-in-law, uncle and friend to countless people. An avid sports fan, Lozzy coached all of his children.
